## Story Sequencing

Learning story sequencing is an essential tool for both reading and everyday life.

I have tested many students in Dibbles and had to report many could not comprehend what the story was about.

### Interactive Example:

- Several students are invited to hold up an illustration from my book, standing **out of order**.
- The rest of the class works together to figure out the correct **story sequence**.
- With Suki or Kong by my side, I ask my therapy dog to tap the illustration if it's in the **right spot**. If it's not, the students keep guessing until they've sequenced the story correctly — learning through teamwork, storytelling, and a little help from our furry friend!
